



DIAGNOSIS:

- Mild Neurocognitive Disorder due to Traumatic Brain Injury affecting:
 - Visual and complex attention
 - Verbal new learning and short-term memory
 - Visual short-term memory
 - Executive functions (i.e. response inhibition, abstract reasoning, new learning)
 - Motor functions
- 2. Major Depressive Disorder, chronic



Plaintiff Exhibit C: Neuropsych Results

The pattern of findings on neuropsychometric testing is consistent with a Mild Neurocognitive Disorder subsequent to a Traumatic Brain Injury as well as persistent postconcussive syndrome (with the inclusion of ongoing headaches, imbalance, nausea, fatigue, irritability). Specifically, there have been clinically significant impairments in executive functions, attention, short-term memory, and motor function that impacts day-to-day life. Overall, in these domains, she will be functioning at a much lower level than her peers.



Was Mr. Volkhov Negligent?

Evidence:

- Ms. Balaam positioned to back tractor-trailer into spot
- Mr. Volkhov waiting; eventually proceeded past
- At time of impact Mr. Volkhov's tractor had already cleared Ms. Balaam's trailer
- No evidence of speeding/uncontrolled driving
- No eyewitnesses
- Conclusion: Defense Verdict



Damages

Evidence:

- Minimal property damages; less than \$1,000
- Ms. Balaam walking and seemingly unhurt
- Ms. Balaam completed her trip
- No loss of consciousness or post-traumatic amnesia
- Mild TBI? But no MRI evidence
- Conclusion: Minor Accident, Minimal Damage



Damages

- Monetary Award?
 - Dr. Shrink? No objective evidence of alleged brain injury causing issues for Ms. Balaam
 - Dr. Jenkins? Forces insufficient to cause TBI
 - Medical expenses? ER visit?
- Fair Verdict? \$15,000 \$25,000
